New Legislation Takes Effect

The Florida Legislature recently passed Senate Bill 7050. The bill, which takes effect July 1, 2023, affects every section of the Florida Election Code. Candidate qualifying, election reporting, and initiative petitions are just a few of the processes affected by 7050. Our office along with other county Elections offices throughout Florida have been working to understand the changes contained in the bill to ensure compliance.

Although many of the changes in SB 7050 impact elections offices and how we administer elections, the new law brings an opportunity for voters to familiarize themselves with voting laws in Florida.
